The Men's last home game resulted in a 2-1 win over North Wellington in a very tight match with plenty of chances at both ends. Oscar 'Golden Gloves' Boyce stood up and made save after save until they got their goal in the 87th minute, which made for a nail-biting final few minutes. Thanks to his extraordinary performance, Oscar was the team MVP and the Supporters Man of the Match.

Last week, the team lost on the road to Napier City Rovers, 1-2. Unfortunately, we missed a first half penalty, and Napier went into halftime a goal up. However, in the second half, the boys came out with intent, taking many long-range shots. Our efforts were eventually rewarded with a goal in the 93rd minute. Our Juniors are off to a fantastic start this season, with a remarkable 770 junior players, marking a 10% increase from last year. Alex Shepherd-Reynolds has announced his retirement from competitive football after eighteen years of senior football. This marks the end of a remarkable era, and we'd like to take a moment to reflect on Alex's impressive career.

During his playing career, Alex played 103 league games for our men's first team, scoring 32 goals.

He also played eight Chatham Cup games, scoring four goals and 81 games for our men's reserves team, scoring 28 goals. He played for our men's under-19 team for three years between 2008-2010.

Alex was a part of our team that won the 2008 National Youth Championship (the Napier Under-19s).

While we don't have complete records of third-team games, we estimate that Alex played about 101 games for them. In his last game for the third team on May 4th, he scored a hat-trick in their 3-0 win.
